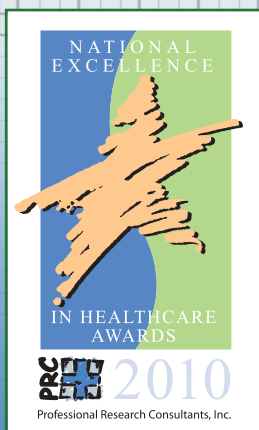
### Improving ASC Flow and Surgeon Satisfaction
